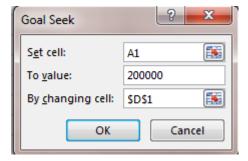

- **F&A verbiage:** The University of Nebraska-Lincoln's federally-negotiated F&A rate is ____% of Modified Total Direct Costs (MTDC) for ______ (e.g., organized research; agricultural research; etc.)
- Modified Total Direct Cost (MTDC) budget exclusions: equipment, capital expenditures (construction),
 patient care costs (mostly for hospitals), GRA tuition remission, rental costs of off-site facilities, participant
 support costs, scholarships and fellowships, and the portion of each subaward in excess of \$25,000
- How to use Excel's Goal Seek feature: When in an Excel file, select the "Data" tab from the ribbon, select
 the "What-If Analysis" drop-down list, then select "Goal Seek...", a Goal Seek dialogue box will pop up. A
 copy of the dialog box is below.



- In the box enter info as follows:
 - **Set cell:** click on the cell you want to set a goal for, or type in the cell letter/number combination
 - To value: type in your goal dollar amount you want to see in the cell set above
 - By changing cell: click on the cell you want to adjust to make the goal in the "Set cell"
 - Click OK, and let Excel calculate for you
- Notes: There are some limitations on which cells can be used for Goal Seek, but it can be extremely
 useful to help you hit a target. The calculation does not update when you make changes. If you
 adjust items in the budget that affect your target, you'll need to run your Goal Seek again.
